# PLANT IMPORT PERMIT

In accordance with the Plant Protection Act 1996 determining the phytosanitary conditions of importation into Seychelles, permission is hereby granted to

MAHS SHIPPING COMPANY LTD.

to import within six months from the date of the signature of the present permit the following items :

The plants and plant products and associated packaging shall not contain either soil, leaves or garden mould, compost, manure, straw or any other organic substances and unsterilized media.

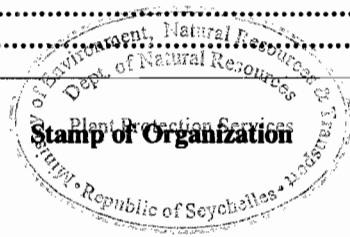
The consignment shall be covered by a PHYTOSANITARY CERTIFICATE issued by an authorized officer of the PLANT PROTECTION ORGANISATION of the country origin. The certificate shall bear the number and date of this permit and the additional declarations similar to those stated hereunder or overleaf:

- NOTE : (i) The plant import permit is issued in duplicate. The original is to be sent to the supplier when making the order for observance of the conditions; the duplicate is handed over with the phytosanitary certificate covering the consignment to the phytosanitary inspector upon arrival of the items.
- (ii) Non-compliance with any of the conditions laid down in this import permit may entail the destruction of the consignment upon arrival without compensation.

# ADDITIONAL DECLARATIONS

1. **BULBS, TUBERS, RHIZOMES, CUTTINGS AND PLANTS FOR PROPAGATION** :- Plant materials free from nematodes and in particular *Ditylenchus* spp. and *Pratylenchus* spp; free from San Jose Scale, *Quadraspidiotus perniciosus*; free from virus diseases and rot caused by *Erwinia* and *Pseudomonas* species; Disinfection treatment with an appropriate fungicide and insecticide is compulsory.
2. **IN-VITRO PLANTLETS** :- Free from serious virus, bacterial or fungal diseases; plantlets must be sterile and pathogen - tested.
3. **FRESH FRUITS** :- Free from fruitflies and in particular *Ceratitidis*, *Dacus Anastrepha*, *Bactrocera* and *Carpomyia* species and free from San Jose Scale.
4. **FRESH VEGETABLES** :- Free from insect pests, nematodes, mites; free from serious fungal, bacterial and viral diseases.
5. **FRESH CUT FLOWERS** :- Free from insects pests and mites within the petals or on the leaves and free from pathogenic microorganisms.
6. **SEEDS** :- Free from seed-borne and seed-transmitted insect pests and serious fungal, bacterial and viral diseases. Seed treatment with an appropriate insecticide and fungicide is compulsory.
7. **GRAINS FOR CONSUMPTION** :- Free from stored product pests and mould growth. Fumigation treatment is compulsory.
8. **GROWING MEDIA FOR PLANT PRODUCTION ( COMPOST, MOSS, VERMICULITE, ETC.)** :- Free from nematodes, insect pests and serious plant diseases. Should not have been used before for plant production; sterilization by heat, fumigation or other appropriate method is compulsory.
9. **ROUGH-SAWN TIMBER** :- Free from insects pest; kiln - dried and treatment/ impregnation with a suitable insecticide/ fungicide or wood preservative is compulsory.
10. **BENEFICIAL ORGANISMS FOR BIOCONTROL AND SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH** :- Free from hyperparasites, pathogens or associated pests and contaminants. The sample must be pure and genetically homogeneous
